MANDATED ETHICS & JURISPRUDENCE COURSE PRACTICING DENTISTRY IN NEW YORK STATE

This course is an overview of the laws, regulations and professional obligations applicable to dentists licensed and practicing in New York State. It is a practical guide for practicing dentistry the right way in New York with solutions to everyday issues. It will inform dentists as to what their offices need to be in compliance (credential posting, required labor notices, inspections requirements, controlled substance records) and the rules of professional responsibility with examples of most common scenarios (abandonment, patient record access, referral and fee-splitting, confidentiality, etc).

The course will be a three-hour duration and satisfies the New York State Education Department requirement of each dentist for the purposes of re-licensure.
